Mon **DC3 Flight – AUCKLAND to NAPIER**

Step aboard your classic DC-3 and take off from Auckland’s Ardmore Airport. Fly above the Waikato, Tokoroa and Taupo. Land in Napier around noon. Meet your coach and drive to a local winery for lunch and wine tasting. See Napier’s highlights afterwards by coach then enjoy time to explore the Marine Parade, Museum and maybe local shopping!

Fly south over Dannevirke, Pahiatua and the Manawatu to reach the Wairarapa. Land at Masterton and drive to the renowned Pukaha Mt Bruce National Wildlife Centre, a sanctuary for native wildlife. You may glimpse the resident albino kiwi. Return to Masterton and a possible visit to the Vintage Aviator collection (a possibility only for now).

Fri **Coach – BLENHEIM to KAIKOURA.**

Drive the Alpine Pacific touring route today. Pass Lake Grassmere’s salt production site, then Ward and Seddon. Mountains on one side and the sea on the other make this a drive to remember. Board your Whale Watch cruise boat to head out in search of the giant sperm whales that reside here year round. Return to Blenheim after an excellent day.

Rejoin your DC-3 and fly across Cook Strait. The North Island coastline will be in sight then the Whanganui River will appear. Land at Whanganui and transfer to the historic paddle wheel ship PS Waimarie for a pleasant lunch cruise. Re-board your DC-3, take off and fly north passing Awakino, Kawhia and Raglan. Land at Ardmore for final farewells!
