



# Warbirds Over Wanaka

Friday 15 April - Tuesday 19 April 2022



**Warbirds over Wanaka is unlike any other aviation event - the mountain scenery and amphitheatre provide a stunning backdrop to an extravaganza of action over Easter weekend. During the show you will see over 80 aircraft including warbirds, jets, helicopters, and some amazing aerobatic displays! See static displays of aircraft, military vehicles, vintage machinery, tractors and cars and more.**

## Day 1 Friday 15 April 2022 ARRIVE QUEENSTOWN

Our tour commences today with our flight from Auckland to Queenstown. On arrival in Queenstown we will meet our driver and coach and enjoy an **orientation tour of Queenstown**, before being transferred to our accommodation for the next few days. The remainder of the day is at leisure to relax or stroll around Queenstown. Dinner tonight is included at the hotel.

## Day 2 Saturday 16 April 2022 WARBIRDS OVER WANAKA AIRSHOW

Today we take the journey across to Wanaka for our tour highlight - the **Warbirds over Wanaka Airshow**. This event held biennially is the largest warbird airshow in the Southern Hemisphere and showcases some of the world's best examples of WWII flying aircraft in action. A **General Admission Pass** to the airshow is included for the weekend giving us the ability to watch the airshow from the flight path (please note there is no seating available with the General Admission pass). There is the option to upgrade at extra cost to a Gold Pass. Warbirds Over Wanaka is famous for attracting a wide variety of privately owned Warbird aircraft along with their modern-day counterparts from the Royal New Zealand Air Force (RNZAF), Royal Australia Air Force (RAAF), United States Air Force (USAF) and French Air Force. While the aircraft are the main focus of the event, there are a lot of other displays on the ground which have made this show so successful over the past 33-years. Some of the aircraft already confirmed for the airshow are the Yak-52 aerobatic team, the Polikarpov I-16, the RNZAF Helicopter NH90, RNZAF Hercules C130H and the RNZAF SSH-2G(I) Seasprite with many more to be announced closer to the date of the show. At the conclusion of the day's events, we retrace our journey back to Queenstown. Tonight is at leisure to sample some of Queenstown's excellent restaurants, cafés and bars.

## Day 3 Sunday 17 April 2022 WARBIRDS OVER WANAKA AIRSHOW

We travel through the Kawarau Gorge past Cromwell to Wanaka for

the final day of the **Warbirds over Wanaka Airshow**. The flying and ground programme is the same as yesterday giving you the perfect opportunity to see your favourite aircraft again or explore the amazing ground displays including aviation trade stands, static display aircraft, market stalls and the Wanaka Warhorses military vehicles. At the conclusion of the airshow we travel back to Queenstown where the remainder of the evening is at leisure.

## Day 4 Monday 18 April 2022 QUEENSTOWN

**Day at leisure to explore Queenstown.** There is a wide choice of optional tours and activities in this marvellous alpine resort such as lake cruises; jet boating; 4WD excursion to Lord of the Rings filming locations; winery tours or if you dare - bungee jumping (extra cost for optional activities). This evening perhaps as an option you may wish to take a cruise across Lake Wakatipu on the steamer TSS Earnslaw to Walter Peak Station to dine at the Colonel's Homestead. This is an additional cost and needs to be pre-booked. Enquire with the office if you wish to book any optional sightseeing.

## Day 5 Tuesday 19 April 2022 DEPART QUEENSTOWN

Today our tour concludes with our flight from Queenstown to Auckland.

### Health and Safety Information Including COVID-19

For the health and safety of all passengers on tour any illness (such as fever, coughing or difficulty breathing) will not be accepted onboard the coach unless they can provide us with a negative Covid19 test result received within the past 72 hours. Should any passenger start to feel unwell on arrival or while on tour, they must immediately advise their tour manager and contact Healthline then visit a medical practitioner/medical centre/hospital. To return to the tour the passenger must be deemed fit and well to participate fully on a coach tour, obtaining and providing us with a written medical clearance – not just a negative Covid19 test. Any costs incurred will be at the passenger's own expense.

### COVID-19 Vaccination

Our passengers' safety, and that of our staff and suppliers, has always been our top priority. As of 1 December 2021, Leisure Time Travel requires all passengers joining our tours to produce proof of full COVID-19 vaccination. If a passenger is unable to be vaccinated for medical reasons, they may apply for an exemption to us by providing a medical certificate to us. Exemptions will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. *Proof of vaccination against COVID-19.* This is your official vaccination certificate (electronic or paper) and it must identify your name and date of vaccination with final dose given at least 14-days before the start date of your tour.

### Payments, Cancellations and Refunds

A non-refundable deposit per person is required at time of booking to confirm your seat. All balance payments must be received by Leisure Time Travel prior to the date specified as per itinerary or your booking confirmation. Payments are available to be made by Cash, Cheque, Direct Credit or EFTPOS only – Credit Card payments are not available without an additional surcharge. Leisure Time Travel reserves the right to amend or reschedule the tour due the result of circumstances outside the company's control. Leisure Time Travel also reserves the right to cancel the tour due to insufficient numbers and in this instance a substitute date will be offered or a full refund will be made available. Tour Price excludes drinks, telephone calls, travel insurance and items of a personal nature.

### Travel Insurance

### New Zealand Cancellation Policy

If you cancel your booking:

- 42+ days prior to tour commencement, loss of non-refundable deposit
- 30-41 days prior to tour commencement your cancellation charge will be 50% of the holiday price (50% refund) plus any applicable supplier cancellation fees
- 30 days prior to tour commencement your cancellation charge will be 100% of the holiday price (no refund)

No refunds on any unused portions of any itinerary. The exception is if a sightseeing service is cancelled by operator due to weather conditions/safety concerns etc and the operator authorises a refund. Any such refunds will be processed through agent.

*Please note that any applicable airline content does not apply to the above refunds – see your airline for their specific cancellation/refund policies.*

### COVID-19 Cancellation and Refund Policy

COVID-19 has created uncertainty for us all, therefore for cancellations directly related to COVID-19, we have negotiated special terms with our suppliers which would override 'normal cancellation' terms as outlined above;

If the New Zealand Government imposes travel restrictions that would impact our ability to deliver your travel package prior to commencing travel, passengers will receive a full credit, less any applicable airline cancellation fees. If travel restrictions are imposed while on tour, we will seek credits on any unused portions of the itinerary from all suppliers. Any applicable credits will first be applied to any additional costs that our company may have incurred on the passenger's behalf e.g. if alternative accommodation or transportation to repatriate the passenger to their home city or nearest airport etc is required. Any remaining refunds will be credited to the booking agent to enable them to pass onto their passenger.
